





I didn't notice the seasons as they passed, but later upon seeing that same tree, it began to have baby buds on it, then the branches became longer and greener leaves. And before you knew it, the tree was full and luscious again.

That's what God does for the Christian believer. "I am the true vine, and my Father is the husbandman. Every branch in me that beareth not fruit he taketh away: and every branch that beareth fruit, he purgeth it, that it may bring forth more fruit" Jh.15:1-2.

Sometimes knowing the season of your life will show you what you should be doing. In that winter season when the tree was ugly, bent, and twisted, it should be our time of rest and listening to the Lord. As you rest and listen, you can fast and pray, because sometimes God is telling us to take inventory of ourselves; slow down and sit with Him. Those times may be some of our most rough times in our lives; some affliction caused by the enemy: losing a job; overcome by sickness; losing a spouse; or going through financial distress and lack, and we're not used to waiting in that time. By sitting and meditating on the God's Word, you will react in a different way and began to heal and receive the promises God has for you, even the desires you have confessed, because you trust in God even through you don't see it yet. Rest does not just consist of laying down doing nothing, but doing that that's beneficial to the body, soul, and spirit. WAYS TO PROTECT YOURSELF TO PREVENT MOSQUITO BITES

- Use bug spray. Look for
 "Permethrin" or "Deet" on the label. Do not use on sunburned
 skin, cuts or rashes.
- If you use bug spray, wash your clothes before you wear them again.
- Get rid of standing water (i.e. in

- pots, buckets, barrels and tire swings). Why? Because mosquitoes breed in standing water.
- Keep children's wading pools empty when not in use.
- Stay inside during times when there are a lot of mosquitoes: during evening, dusk, and even until dawn.
- When outside wear long sleeves shirts and long pants.
- Put screens on your windows and doors.
- Don't wear perfume or cologne when you go outside for a long time.
- If you find a dead bird, call your local Health Department.
