LOVE HAS NO BOUNDS: Isn't it funny how God's Love is always with us no matter how we act. The bible says, *"But God commendeth His love toward us (He demonstrated, he showed, He proved his love) in that while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us."* Rom.5:8

Love being an action word:

- **What** did Christ do? - He died on the cross for us.
- **Why** did He do it? - He died because He loved us.
- **When** did He do it? - While we were still helpless, hostile and rebellious sinners.

The SOLUTION for the err of our helpless, hostile rebellious hearts is God's Love through Christ Jesus.

Love doesn't come any bolder than that.

When we truly know, be-

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CONTEND EARNESTLY FOR THE FAITH: THE EPISTLE OF JUDE 3

Jude identifies himself as the servant of Jesus Christ and the brother of James, Jude is the English form of the name Judas (loudas), the Greek form of Judah which literally means to give thanks, or praise. The English version of the name is used in most versions of the bible to disassociate Jude from Judas Iscariot.

The book of Jude is an important book for us today because it is written for the end times for the end of the church age. The Church Age began at the Day of Pentecost. Jude is the only book given entirely to the great apostasy meaning when the church became faithless. He admonishes us to contend for our faith, for there

are tares among the wheat, false brethren are in the Church, the saints are in danger. A small but important book worthy of studying it for ourselves, written for the Christian of today. Therefore Jude wants the reader to understand that in the face of pressure due to false Christian doctrine we should stand firm and *look to*

the hills from which cometh our help and all of our help comes from the Lord.

How can one earnestly contend for the faith? We must be on guard for false doctrine which can so easily deceive us if we are not well versed in the word.

We need to know the gospel, protect, and defend it, and accept the Lordship of Christ, which is our evidence of a changed life. The most effective Christian life is one that lives the faith in everyday life. **Real faith always reflects Christ-like behavior.**

Our hearts and souls should overflow with love and faith which is a gift of God.

We need a personal relationship with Him, only then will we know His voice, so a stranger we will not follow.

should work diligently in staying in the will of God.
