Vashti, the wife of King (Xerxes) Ahasuerus of Persia was alone, against a government totally dominated by men. Susan B. Anthony a women's rights' activist grew up knowing that the rights of women were not equal to men. She revolted against it, and made a big difference because of the Christian principles that forced men to modify their methods. This is "Defining Moment!" times that amount. She decided to draw up a "Declaration of Rights for Women", and she presented it to the New York legislature. She got the signatures of ten thousand women, but the bill was rejected. She went back to the people and kept gathering signatures, and kept lecturing across the state. She covered 54 out of 60 counties, and every time she went to the legislature she was turned down. Six times she went with her petitions, and six times she was rejected. Finally, after unbelievable personal sacrifice, she returned the seventh time (the number for completion), and in 1860 the New York legislature adopted a bill granting women the right to own property, and the right to the money they earned, plus other rights.

The next battle was women's right to vote. She persuaded 15 other brave women to join her, and they marched into the polling headquarters in Rochester in

1872. She told the election inspectors they were there to vote. They told her it was illegal. She pulled out a copy of the U.S. Constitution and said, "Prove it!" They couldn't, and so she and her three sisters, and other women, voted. The newspapers splashed the incident across their front pages.

But for Vashti, there was a much different report of what King Xerxes advisers

However, being born in 1820 into a Quaker family where women were treated with respect, equality was much different in the world. Her father went bankrupt, and so she and her sisters became teachers. For 15 years they taught earning three dollars a week as their top salary while men CON'T:

had told him. "These women had to be punished, or all women would think they had a right to vote or do as they pleased." Had Susan B. Anthony lived in Persia, she would have gotten no further than Vashti, but she lived in America (South Adams, Massachusetts), and had the freedom to express her views. She toured the Midwest and drew large crowds to her lecture which was titled, "Is It A Crime For A U.S. Citizen To Vote?" We don't have time to look at her spectacular trial, but she won, and went on to be President of "The National" Women's Suffrage Association" to prepare the way for the 19th Amendment that gave women the right to vote. By her rebellion she changed the course of history. She did it, because like Vashti, she had the courage to say "No", and refused to submit to what was not right. I believe Queen Vashti has gotten a bad rap for not adhering to the king to go before a group of

a very dear price for humiliating the King. Yes, she could have gone to the banquet. She didn't and we have to know when to fight and when not to fight. Before we can have our way, God will first have His way.

God's plan at this time would be to save the Jewish race. This was a "Defining Moment!" Vashti's time was over, that's all to it. Her season is over. God would save the Jewish race from annihilation with Vashti's rejection, by bringing forth the acceptance of using a new Queen. In that era the law of the king ruled and the men thought they had won, but God still used a woman.

And it was to be fulfilled through prayer and fasting by the transformation of a new Queen. In Susan B. Anthony's case, it was God's timing and it was done in a different way. Praise God for women! God is not tied in a box in how change will come about.

He only shows us glimpses. He does not give us a glimpse of what it could be or should be, and not do something about it. We only have to allow God to do His thing while we trust! It will always be a time of courage whether we do it right or wrong. God takes our courage and sometimes rejection is in the plan. We never fail because He is a recovering God! He is a God who keeps His promises in the most unique ways. He's a God that can change man's thoughts and hearts at His Word and by His Spirit. DEHYDRATION

Dehydration is the result of not having enough body fluids for your body to function well.

1. CAUSES

- Dehydration can be caused by loss of fluids sweating from too much, vomiting, diarrhea or heavy urine output.
- You can also become dehydrated if you are not taking in enough liquid which is sometimes the result of a loss of appetite or of nausea.

2. SYMPTOMS

- Decreased urine output.
- Dry mouth.
- Dark circles under the

eyes.

- Decreased activity in children.
- Fatigue in adults.

3. LATE SIGNS OF **DEHYDRATION**

- Confusion. weakness, and fainting.
- Skin lacking its norelasticity mal and sagging back into position slowly when pinched into a fold.

4. PREVENTION

- Drink adequate fluids throughout the day no matter how active or inactive you are or whether you are ill.
- Monitor fluid intake and drink more than normal if you are ill.
- Children be encour-

aged to drink at least 5 ounces of water minutes 20 every during exercise in warm or humid climates.

Drink at least a quart of water or other electrolytereplenishing fluid every hour when you are sweating or doing exercise.

5. FIRST AID

- Mild dehydration can be treated by drinking water or other decaffeinated fluids such as sport's drinks.
- Get proper rest.
- If you are experiencing any of the signs of late dehydration, you need to see your doctor. You may need to receive fluids through your veins

intravenously (IV).

- Severe dehydration can result in Cardiovascular collapse: and death if not treated immediately.
- Infants and young children may benefit from specific electrolyte solutions as Pedialyte. Infants with frequent vomiting and diarrhea are at the areatest risk for dehvdration and need to seek medical attention.


